New facility for charities wanting to work with local government

If your charity wants to work with local government to deliver public services or take part in policy development consultations, GuideStar UK can help you communicate with them easily, for free. The [update my charity facility](#) now includes new fields and uploads sections allowing your charity to deposit all relevant information needed by local government in one place. This additional information will allow registered local government organisations to perform first level due diligence checks and involve third sector organisations in policy consultations through our new [Local Government Intelligence Service](#). This link also provides more information about how to make the most of the facility.
